

## May 19, 2022 – Bulletin # 2 – End of May Weed Treatment Schedule and Map

Please reference the weed treatment map below to better understand this message as to late-May weed treatment dates and a <u>5-day lawn irrigation restriction</u> due to each of these treatments. You may want to turn off your lawn irrigation pump for the 5 days after the treatment in your area or you risk damaging your lawn or plants. Please note any additional restrictions, if any, on the <u>Yellow Treatment Notices</u> placed in lakeside yards within the treatment areas on the day of treatment.

On Monday, May 23, weather permitting, areas on the map designated as EWM 2, 3, and 4 will be treated with ProcellaCor, a relatively new herbicide that targets Eurasian Water Milfoil (EWM) with minimal to no effect on other weed species. You will find these areas on the righthand side of the map color designated as blue, green, and red. These areas constitute approximately 25 acres containing various densities of EWM. These are LARE treatment areas with 80% of the treatment cost covered by the LARE grant and the remaining 20% to be paid by WLCA member dues and contributions to the weed fund.

Also, on Monday the 23<sup>rd</sup>, shorelines and channels that are outside the LARE treatment areas will receive herbicide treatments consisting of a mix of herbicides and algaecides, not including ProcellaCor. The shoreline areas subject to treatment total 39 acres and the channel areas to be treated total 14 acres. Please reference the map as to whether your shoreline or channel is included in this treatment. Treatment costs for shoreline and channel treatments are paid for totally by WLCA member dues and contributions to the weed fund.

On Thursday, May 26, weather permitting, EWM Area 1 (on the right of the map in yellow) will be treated with 2,4-D and will exclude the shoreline area immediately around the island in that area. There are 36.75 acres in this area when the island area is excluded. This is a LARE grant area with cost of treatment covered by LARE at 80% and by WLCA member dues and contributions at 20%.

Other non-highlighted shorelines and channels that are within a LARE treatment area, including the prior, May 4 LARE treatment areas for Curlyleaf Pondweed, will be treated after the required 21 day waiting period between treatments unless excluded for treatment by the DNR. The date of these treatments has not been determined as yet.

Note: Lilly Pad beds are considered "protected" and are excluded from any treatment.
