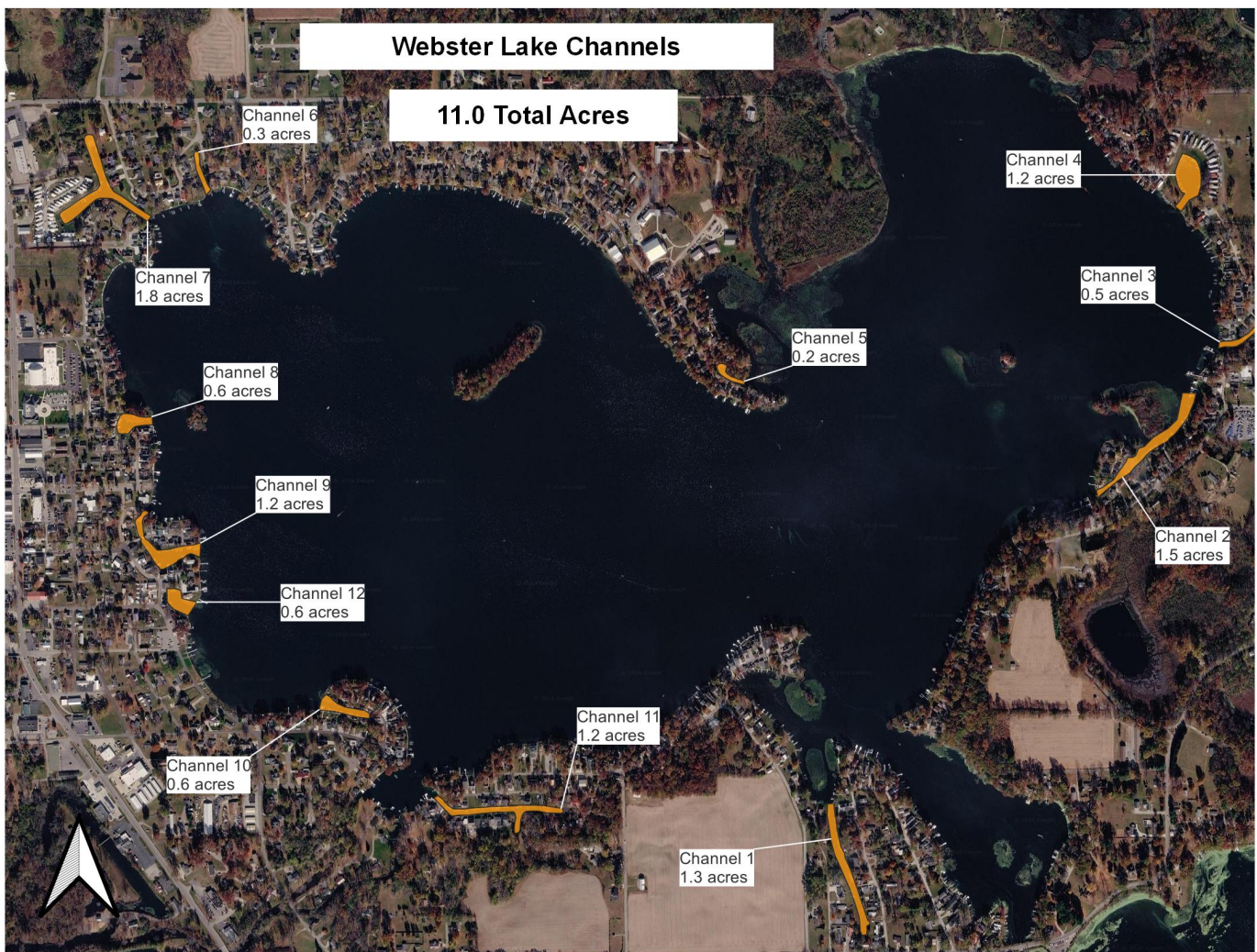




NOTICE: TWO HERBICIDE TREATMENTS AT WEBSTER LAKE
Scheduled: May 4 - 8 (Weather Permitting)

1. Treatment for invasive Curly Leaf Pondweed and Eurasian Water Milfoil on 12 channels on Webster Lake will occur as designated on the map below Webster Lake (approx. 11 acres). Please refer to the map below for specific locations. Early spring treatments, when weeds are smaller, help minimize weed mass and weed chop and give native plants the opportunity to take over in that area.



Water Use Restrictions for Channel Treatments:

- **Fishing & Swimming:** No restriction
- **Drinking Water:** 2-day restriction
- **Pets/Livestock:** 1-day restriction
- **Turf & Ornamentals Irrigation:** 3-day restriction
- **Food Crops Irrigation:** 5-day restriction

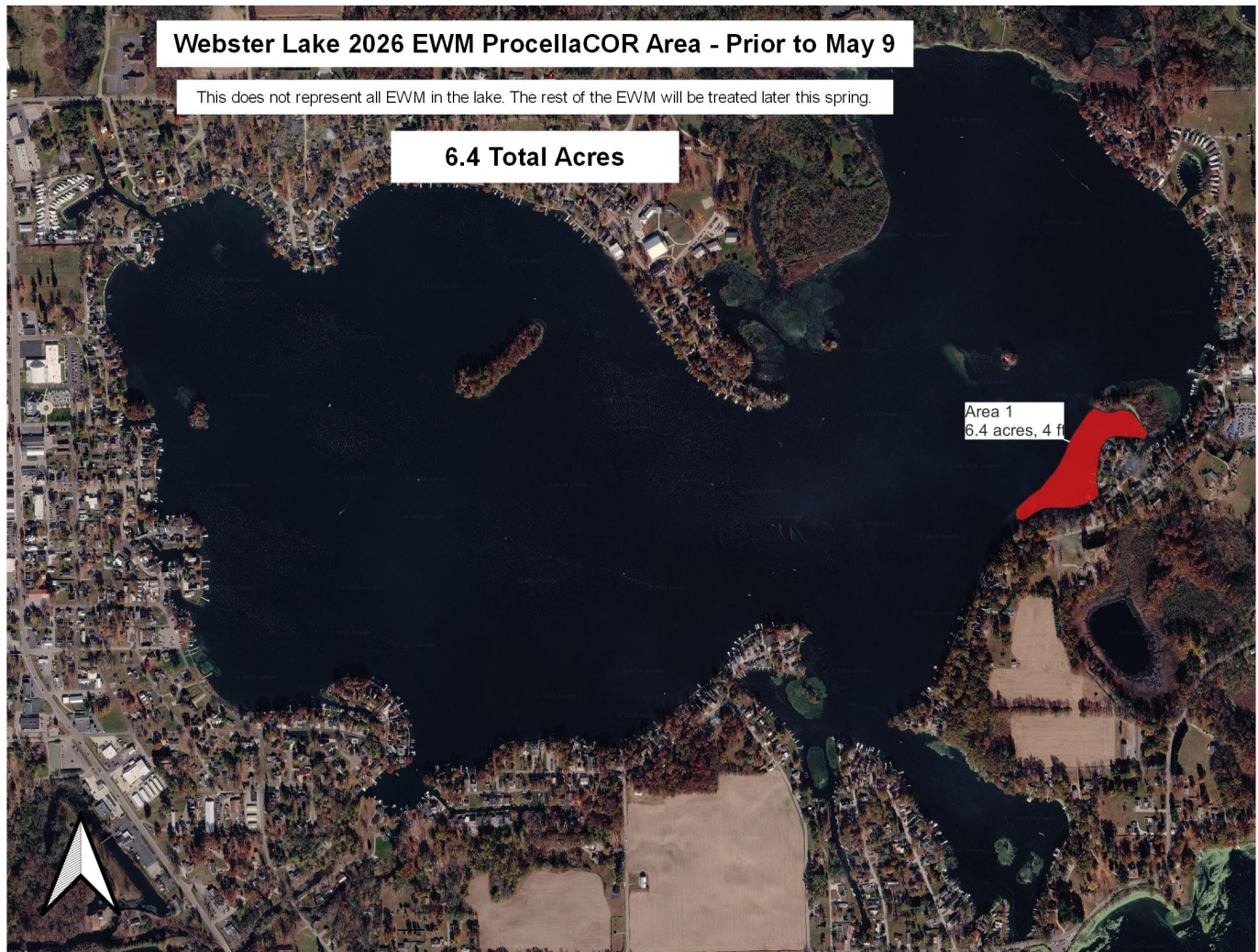
If you use lake water for irrigation, **shut your system off before treatment and keep it off for 5 days.**

Funding & Costs

WLCA will fund this treatment with member dues and donations. Our LARE Grant does not pay for shoreline and channel treatments. Your generous contribution to the Weed Fund is most important.

2. Treatment for invasive Eurasian Water Milfoil with the selective herbicide

ProcellaCOR may occur between May 4 and May 8, if WLCA receives the signed LARE Purchase Order from the State before or during these treatment dates. Otherwise, this treatment cannot be done until after the purchase order is received, and after May 17, due to the treatment blackout days for the Muskie Fishing Tournament. Treatment will be in the area designated on the map below. (approx. 6.4 acres). This is a limited treatment as the Milfoil in this area is ahead of that in other parts of the lake.



Water Use Restrictions for Eurasian Water Milfoil Treatments – Procella COR

- All Irrigation: 7 days
- Swimming: 0 days
- Fishing: 0 days
- All Drinking Water: 0 Days

If you use lake water for irrigation, **shut your system off before treatment and keep it off for 7 days.**

Funding & Costs

A LARE Grant from Indiana Department of Natural Resources – Division of Fish and Wildlife will fund 80% this treatment with member dues and donations funding the remainder. Your generous contribution to the Weed Fund is most important.

Additional Notes

- Future treatment dates for the remaining Eurasian Water Milfoil and nuisance native weeds in shoreline areas will be announced via email.
- Help eliminate “weed chop” by not boating through weed beds until after weeds have died down and by removing floating weeds from your shoreline, drying them, and disposing of them as trash.
